6 billion USD invested in its transport infrastructure since 2008

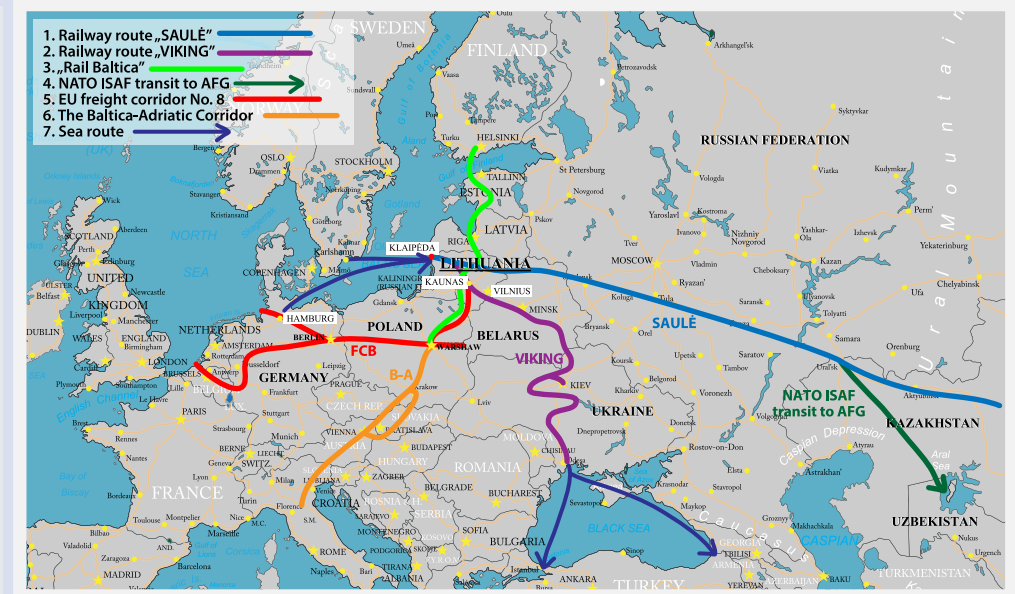

Railway transport

- Annual load capacity – 200 million tons
- International railway projects:
 - container train “Viking”; 52 hours from Klaipėda/Baltic Sea to/from Odessa/Black Sea/Turkey
 - container train “Saulė”; 13 days from Lithuania/EU to/from Kazakhstan/Chinese border
 - “Rail Baltica” infrastructure project; integration to European railway network through interoperability of wide and narrow gauge standards

Klaipėda Sea Port

- The northernmost ice-free deep-water port in the Baltic Sea; depth 14,5 meters (Post-Panamax ships)
- Annual cargo throughput capacity 60 million tons: fertilizers, oil products, Ro-Ro
- 650 000 TEUs per year capacity; MSC hub for Baltic States; Maersk, DFDS offices
- LNG terminal (first in the Baltic States, will start operating as of 1st January 2015; capacity - 4 billion m³)
- Būtingė Crude Oil Terminal
 - Annual export capacity 14 million tons
 - Annual import capacity 12 million tons
- Experience in delivering NATO ISAF cargo shipments



Road transport

- 29000 trucks from Lithuania operating internationally
- Cargo transportation services between the EU and Eastern Europe, Central Asia and beyond
- Pan European IXB corridor highway from LT/BY border to Klaipėda
- Via Baltica highway connecting Baltic States to West Europe

Four international Airports

(Vilnius, Kaunas, Palanga/Klaipėda, Šiauliai)

- Capacity to handle B747 in Vilnius, Kaunas and Šiauliai airports
- Expanded air route network
- Cargo handling services (FedEx, UPS, DHL)
